The construction of this project will be in the vicinity of the county below and discharge to Receiving Permit ID below:

for the construction of (described construction project):

Hickory Trails Subdivision Phase 1, Stage 3-Construction of approximately 4,085 lf of 8-inch PVC SDR-35 gravity sewer lines with approximately 22 manholes to serve a 277 PE and a design average flow of 27,650 gpd.

Project is in the vicinity of Hickory Trails Drive in Wright City, Warren County and discharges to an existing system to be treated at SCCPWS #2, Hickory Trails WWTF, MO-0136204. David S. Mathon PE, Engineering Manager, with Public Water Supply District #2 of St. Charles County provided an acceptance letter dated March 5, 2021.

Construction of such proposed facilities shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Missouri Clean Water Law, Chapter 644, RSMo, and regulation promulgated thereunder, or this permit may be revoked by the Department of Natural Resources (Department). As the Department does not examine structural features of design or the efficiency of mechanical equipment, the issuance of this permit does not include approval of these features.

This permit applies only to the construction of water pollution control components; it does not apply to other environmentally regulated areas.
